A.2) RESEARCH PROFILE

My research profile is marked by a strong interest in studying gnoseological, metaphysical and anthropological problems as presented in Authors of different historical periods, mostly within the different traditions of Modern and Contemporary philosophy. My initial research projects (PhD Thesis and first publications) addressed the realist, and teleological, interpretation of Kant's philosophy developed by Joseph Maréchal. This philosopher, similarly to others in the Louvain school, has engaged in re-examining the fundamental categories of Modern Philosophy and Metaphysics in the light of Kant's critical project; in particular, my approach was to examine Maréchal's contribution to the research for the transcendental foundation of ontological affirmation. Several studies followed this research line and lastly converged to my monography, *Forma e finalità dell'intelletto. Deduzione trascendentale e oggettività della conoscenza in Joseph Maréchal* (Roma 2025).

My subsequent planned volume (tentative title, *Metaphysics in Modern Philosophy*, 2026) will consist in a study devoted to metaphysical, logical, and natural theology themes, undertaken through a rigorous engagement with pivotal authors in the history of modern philosophy (Descartes, Spinoza, Leibniz, Kant, Hegel, toward which I dedicated my already published papers production), alongside the principal contemporary interpretative frameworks of their doctrines.

Furthermore, my research interests took into account the attempt of formulating an epistemological – rather than theological or metaphysical – idealist system undertaken by the followers of Maréchal's School. Specifically, I analysed the relationship of philosophical parentage existing within, from one side, Classical German Idealism and, from the other side, the Italian philosophical landscape of the first half of the XX century, and in particular the ties between Gustavo Bontadini (to which I devoted a monography, forthcoming in late 2025: *Idealismo e realismo in Gustavo Bontadini*) and Giovanni Gentile. Therefore, in this specific fields, my research involved and partly currently still involves three branches:

- An account of classical metaphysics and its response to Kant's critical project, attempting to formulate a realist account based on metaphysics and not only on epistemology.

- An analysis of dialectics as a method of refuting (*elenchos*) the contradictory aspects of “becoming”, as testified by my forthcoming book – *Metaphysics of Intellect and Necessity: Neo-Scholasticism and Neo-Parmenidism*.
- The category of «unity of experience» as developed by Bontadini, as an ideal correlate to the cross-breeding of transcendental idealism and empirical realism formulated by Kant in his *Refutation of Idealism* (KrV).

The subsequent research activities I carried out have been developed along the line traced that I’ve summarized above and with a broadening of interests and Authors I referred to, always in a close reference to my field of research (metaphysics, theoretical philosophy and history of modern philosophy). As the complete list of my publications (peer-reviewed) and international paper presentations in this CV attests, I’ve have studied especially:

1. Metaphysics in Modern Philosophy:

- Apperception in Descartes and Leibniz
- Transcendental deduction and the Ontology of Knowledge
- The distinction/relation between Transcendental and Transcendence in Kant
- The idea of «Zweckmäßigkeit», the System of Nature and the notion of Affinity in Kant's «Critique of Judgement» and «Anthropology».
- Hegel: Matter, Extension and the idea of Work
- Necessity, generativity of Thought and Consciousness in Hegel's Jena writings.

2. Natural Theology and Philosophy of Religion:

- The possibility of Revelation and Theological Anthropomorphism from a critical point of view
- Philosophical and Theological Reason in Kant
- Desire and Absolute in human Understanding
- The ontological argument for the existence of God: analytical debate and classical objections

3. Themes in Classical Metaphysics (in relation with contemporary Anthropology):

- The notion of matter as a limit of Thought
- Philosophy as «Paideia»
- Idealism and realism according to the neo-scholastics of the 19th and 20th centuries
- Aristotle and Kant on Teleology and Metaphysics
- A Metaphysical approach to human work, and its ethical issues, in contemporary world

In my future research endeavours, I will continue to explore Kant’s metaphysics, as well as other aspects of his philosophy. Furthermore, I will expand my research to encompass contemporary metaphysics in Analytic Philosophy, as I plan to continue investigating the proofs for God’s existence developed in the contemporary landscape, having as a target the publishing of a new Introduction to Logic and Natural Theology within the context of Analytic Philosophy. In addition, in an historical and historiographical perspective, I’ll continue working at a research project named “Traditions and Texts”: basically, I founded, with some colleagues here in Rome and abroad, specialist in Medieval and Modern Philosophy, a research project in Medieval and Modern Metaphysics, with the idea/goal of organising every year a conference either “from Medieval texts and tradition to contemporary debate”, or “from Modern texts and tradition to contemporary debate”. We’ve already organised three conferences and we’re going on to proceed to the 4th, and we also edited the special journal issue, Luise G. – Petagine A. (eds.), *Substance and Accidents: Views and Developments from the Late Middle Ages to the Modern Age*, Special Issue of *Acta Philosophica*, vol. 31/2022 (Class A Journal – ANVUR). Finally, I am now committed to a larger interdisciplinary and international (2024-20276) project that I am currently running as a PI, along with other Colleagues, entitled: **Rediscovering the individual: misadventures, drifts and returns of a fundamental notion. An inquiry into a reshaped**

metaphysics. Conferences, experts meeting and designing of large impact international publications are already ongoing and will do in ten next 3-4 academic years.

I will continue, as I did from the beginning of my activity, to present regularly the finding of my research at international specialized conferences and congresses (most of them with a double-blind process of strict selection of the paper to be accepted), in order to be present with personal and original in the major proceeding publications and research networks. A list of my active memberships is specified in this CV, but here I could underline that I'm working with research groups on Modern and Contemporary Metaphysics in France (ENS, Paris 1, Lyon 3), Germany (Universität Trier), Spain (University of Navarra, in Pamplona and Barcelona), US (Vanderbilt University, Nashville) and of course in Italy (Università di Roma "La Sapienza"; Università Cattolica del Sacro Cuore, Milan; Università di Catania; SISSA-Trieste, Scuola Normale Superiore, Pisa).
